5. Village President's Agenda

- a. Village President Bill Hintz proclaims the Village's support of **Distracted Driving Awareness Month** in April 2021 and strongly urges the citizens and businesses of Carbon Cliff to observe Distracted Driving Awareness Month by practicing safe driving behaviors and pledging to drive distraction-free.
- b.
