



Carbon Cliff Board of Trustees Meeting 1001 Mansur Avenue, Carbon Cliff, Illinois September 21, 2021 @ 7:00 p.m. MINUTES

Village President Bill Hintz called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m.

5. Village President's Agenda

- a. Approved Motion for Yearly Operation and Maintenance Service Contract with ION Environmental Solutions, Muscatine, lowa for an annual cost of \$41,820.00 (\$3,485.00 per month) for the purpose of acting as our Responsible Operator in Charge and keeping up with the daily operations of our water system. Trustee Dreher did bring up to change 2.1 in the contract from the verbiage wastewater and replace it to water treatment facility. Will bring to the attention of the lawyer and ION representative.
- b. Village Director, Nick Gottwalt was notified on Wednesday, September 15th that the Village received a grant from the USDA in the amount of \$34,000.00 to cover the cost of purchasing and installing a generator at the Village Hall / Public Works Building. The Village will be responsible for covering the remaining costs. The expected cost the Village will incur is forecasted to be between \$10,000 to \$15,000.

Trustee Robert Dreher joined the meeting at 7:05 p.m.

c. Informational – the Illinois Joint Purchasing Program will award and release the Winter 2021-22 Season salt prices on September 23rd. The Village has requested 100 tons with an obligation to 80 tons.

a. Letter dated September 13, 2021, from the Illinois DOT announcing that Illinois 5 / 92 in East Moline will be closed at the BNSF Railway crossing from Monday, Sept. 20, through Saturday, Sept. 25. The crossing is located between Morton Drive and Barstow Road. The closure will allow the BNSF Railway to remove and replace their at-grade crossing and repave the approaches. There will be a marked detour directing traffic to Morton Drive, 40th Street, 158th Street North and Barstow Road.
