## ORDINANCE NO. 11-30

### AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE VI, ARTICLE 9, SECTION 5, PARAGRAPHS 5.1, 5.1(a-d), 5.2(b) AND 5.2(b)(1) OF THE VILLAGE CODE (SEWER RATES)

**WHEREAS**, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Carbon Cliff deem that the Village needs to keep current its basic user rate for sewer service;

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Carbon Cliff that:

**SECTION ONE:** Title VI, Article 9, Section 5, Paragraphs 5.1, 5.1(a-d), 5.2(b) and 5.2(b)(1) are hereby deleted;

**SECTION TWO:** Title VI, Article 9, Section 5, Paragraphs 5.1, 5.1(a-d), 5.2(b) and 5.2(b)(1) of the Village Code shall be as follows:

- I. **SEWER RATES.** For a term commencing October 1, 2011 thru September 30, 2012, there shall be and there is established a basic user rate for the use of and for the service supplied by the wastewater facilities of the Village.

#### **TITLE VI, ARTICLE 9, SECTION 5.1.**

- (a) **RESIDENTIAL:** A minimum charge of **TWENTY-THREE DOLLARS AND NINETY CENTS (\$23.90)** per month shall be applied to all residential metered users for the consumption of the initial Two Thousand Five Hundred (2,500) gallons of water per month. In addition to the minimum charge, a basic user rate of **FIVE DOLLARS AND FORTY-SEVEN CENTS (\$5.47)** per One Thousand (1,000) gallons shall be applied to all residential metered users for consumption in excess of Two Thousand Five Hundred (2,500) gallons per month.
- (b) **MULTIPLE HOMES:** For multiple home units occupied as residential units and served by a single meter, a minimum charge of **TWENTY-THREE DOLLARS AND NINETY CENTS (\$23.90)** shall be applied per month on the first unit and a minimum charge of **ELEVEN DOLLARS AND TWENTY-EIGHT CENTS (\$11.28)** shall be applied for each additional unit serviced by the meter for the consumption of the initial Two Thousand Five Hundred (2,500) gallons of water per month. In addition to the minimum charges, a basic user rate of **FIVE DOLLARS AND FORTY-SEVEN CENTS (\$5.47)** per One Thousand (1,000) gallons shall be applied to all water consumed in excess of the initial Two Thousand Five Hundred (2,500) gallons per month passing through the meter.
- (c) **NON-METERED:** A basic user charge of **THIRTY-SEVEN DOLLARS AND FIFTY-FIVE CENTS (\$37.55)** per month shall be applied to all non-metered users. A non-metered user is one where only sewage use is desired, no Village water is used, and water consumption is not metered.

- (d) COMMERCIAL: A minimum charge of **NINETY-SIX DOLLARS AND SEVENTY THREE CENTS (\$96.73)** per calendar quarter shall be applied to the consumption of the initial Ten Thousand (10,000) gallons of water per calendar quarter to all commercial users zoned for the Village zoning purposes as C-1, C-2, I-1, I-2, and including all restaurants and industrial zoned users, except those industrial users who are subject to the industrial cost recovery charge as outlined in Title VI, Article 10. In addition to the minimum charge, a basic user rate of **TEN DOLLARS AND NINETY-ONE CENT (\$10.91)** per One Thousand (1,000) gallons shall be applied for consumption in excess of Ten Thousand gallons (10,000) per calendar quarter.

#### **TITLE VI, ARTICLE 9, SECTION 5.2.**

- (b) SENIOR: All persons who qualify for Senior Citizen's Rates, both metered users for water consumption and non-metered users for water consumption, shall pay the following basic Senior Citizens' Users Rate:
- (1) A basic Senior Citizens' Users Rate of **TWENTY-THREE DOLLARS AND NINETY CENTS (\$23.90)** for each month or **SEVENTY-ONE DOLLARS AND SEVENTY CENTS (\$71.70)** per quarter.

- II. SEWER RATES. For a term commencing on October 1, 2012, there shall be and there is established a basic user rate for the use of and for the service supplied by the wastewater facilities of the Village.

#### **TITLE VI, ARTICLE 9, SECTION 5.1.**

- (a) RESIDENTIAL: A minimum charge of **TWENTY-SIX DOLLARS AND TWENTY-NINE CENTS (\$26.29)** per month shall be applied to all residential metered users for the consumption of the initial Two Thousand Five Hundred (2,500) gallons of water per month. In addition to the minimum charge, a basic user rate of **SIX DOLLARS AND TWO (\$6.02)** per One Thousand (1,000) gallons shall be applied to all residential metered users for consumption in excess of Two Thousand Five Hundred (2,500) gallons per month.
- (b) MULTIPLE HOMES: For multiple home units occupied as residential units and served by a single meter, a minimum charge of **TWENTY-SIX DOLLARS AND TWENTY-NINE CENTS (\$26.29)** shall be applied per month on the first unit and a minimum charge of **TWELVE DOLLARS AND FORTY-ONE CENTS (\$12.41)** shall be applied for each additional unit serviced by the meter for the consumption of the initial Two Thousand Five Hundred (2,500) gallons of water per month. In addition to the minimum charges, a basic user rate of **SIX DOLLARS AND TWO CENTS (\$6.02)** per One Thousand (1,000) gallons shall be applied to all water consumed in excess of the initial Two Thousand Five Hundred (2,500) gallons per month passing through the meter.
- (c) NON-METERED: A basic user charge of **FORTY-ONE DOLLARS AND THIRTY-ONE CENTS (\$41.31)** per month shall be applied to all non-metered users. A non-metered user is one where only sewage use is desired, no Village water is used, and water consumption is not metered.
- (d) COMMERCIAL: A minimum charge of **ONE HUNDRED SIX DOLLARS AND FORTY CENTS (\$106.40)** per calendar quarter shall be applied to the consumption of the initial Ten Thousand (10,000) gallons of water per calendar quarter to all commercial users zoned for the Village zoning purposes as C-1, C-2, I-1, I-2, and including all restaurants and industrial zoned users, except those industrial users who are subject to the industrial cost recovery charge as outlined in Title VI, Article 10. In addition to the minimum charge, a basic user rate of **TWELVE DOLLARS (\$12.00)** per One Thousand (1,000) gallons shall be applied for consumption in excess of Ten Thousand gallons (10,000) per calendar quarter.

**TITLE VI, ARTICLE 9, SECTION 5.2.**

(b) SENIOR: All persons who qualify for Senior Citizen's Rates, both metered users for water consumption and non-metered users for water consumption, shall pay the following basic Senior Citizens' Users Rate:

- (1) A basic Senior Citizens' Users Rate of **TWENTY-SIX DOLLARS AND TWENTY-NINE CENTS (\$26.29)** for each month or **SEVENTY-EIGHT DOLLARS AND EIGHTY-SEVEN CENTS (\$78.87)** per quarter.

**SECTION THREE:** This ordinance shall be recorded in the Recorder's Office, Rock Island County, Illinois.

**SECTION FOUR:** This ordinance shall be effective retroactive to October 1, 2011.

**SECTION FIVE:** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as required by law.

**ADOPTED** by the Board of Trustees for the Village of Carbon Cliff, Illinois, this 18<sup>th</sup> day of October 2011, pursuant to a roll call vote as follows:

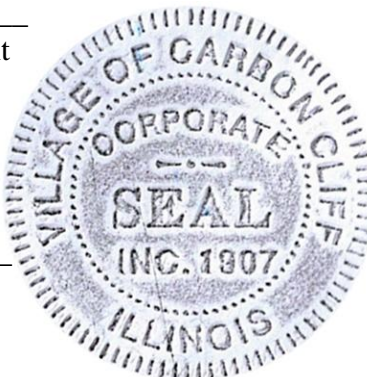
