- A. Village President Bill Hintz informed the Board that Langman Construction had begun working on 6th Street on Thursday, September 28th, and the Village had a few phone calls regarding the mailboxes and mail delivery. Director Gottwalt explained to the Board the mix-up between the East Moline Post Office and the Carbon Cliff Post Office. The mail was to be held at the Carbon Cliff Post Office for residents to pick up starting Thursday, however, the East Moline Post Office did not inform the Carbon Cliff Post Office to hold mail until late Friday, September 29th.
- B. The North 1st Avenue drainage project is still on hold while we wait for MidAmerican Energy to move a gas line.

- D. There was a discussion regarding the proposal for architectural services from Streamline Architects. Some Board members did not fully understand the proposal, nor the layout desired by Trustee Dreher and the Public Properties Committee. There was also discussion as to whether or not there was a need to separate residents from the staff or if security glass and doors were really needed. Trustee Dreher did remind the Board that two residents had been trespassed from the property within the last year and that he felt the safety of our employees justified the project. The proposal will be placed back on the agenda for October 17, 2023. The project consists of security cameras, updated card readers for all entryway doors, security glass, and enclosing the front desk area to provide separation between the public and the office spaces.
