<u>East Moline—Carbon Cliff Water Interconnect Project</u>:

- The village still needs to complete the construction of a pit near the railroad and a booster on Valley View, as well as phase 2 of the IL 84 water main extension, before connecting to East Moline. Most of this was planned to be completed through the USDA Loan Funding. The Village will apply for a new permit through the Illinois Department of Transportation (IL-DOT) to utilize their easement and bypass the property owned by Hawkeye Land.
- Discuss and review cost estimates for the remaining water connections to East Moline.

At this time, we will proceed, anticipating that the funding will still be available for this year. The Village will conduct a walkability checklist. Eagle Ridge School has returned the "Parent Survey about Walking and Biking to School". Does IMEG have the ability to do a traffic study for Valley View and Pleasant Avenue?
